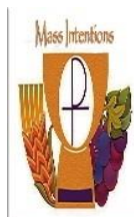

SUNDAY READINGS

First Reading: Acts 2: 1-11

Psalms 104: "Lord, send forth your Spirit,
 and renew the face of the earth."

Second Reading: Corinthians 12: 3-7, 12-13

Gospel: John 20: 19-23

REFLECTION

The mystery of the Trinity refers to one God in three persons. We frequently acknowledge Jesus as "the second person of the Trinity," but referring also to the Spirit as a "person" comes less naturally. In religious art, the Holy Spirit often appears as a dove or, as in today's reading from the Acts of the Apostles, tongues of fire. Much rarer are images of the Spirit as a "person" in recognizable human form. Today's readings do not settle the issue of how to picture the Spirit, but they certainly give shape to the Spirit's active power in the world and in each human heart. In Acts, the Spirit enables people to speak and

understand a variety of languages. St. Paul's letter to the Corinthians praises the Spirit for all kinds of spiritual gifts, services, and "workings." Finally, in John's Gospel, Jesus calls the Spirit our Advocate and our divine teacher.

During the month of June we focus on the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Throughout this month we will offer practical suggestions for Devotion to the Sacred Heart.

1. ***Make a Holy Hour of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament***
 Spending an hour with Jesus is the only thing relating to himself that he specifically asked of us, when he said in the Garden of Gethsemane:
"So, could you not watch with me one hour?" (Matthew 26:30)

SUNDAY MASS OBLIGATION

On March 13, 2020, Cardinal Collins issued a communication to the faithful of this archdiocese indicating that it was necessary to cancel public celebrations of the Eucharist on the coming Sunday, stating: "For this weekend and any other which may be required, I grant the faithful dispensation from their Sunday obligation". Given that most of the health and safety restrictions in our parishes are no longer in

place and the faithful are able to attend the celebration of the Eucharist once again, the basis for the ***dispensation from the Sunday obligation has dissipated and is no longer in effect.***
