The reign of the Lord glorified in today's Psalm is a kingdom of justice for the oppressed. The other readings, too, all focus on God's loving concern for the poor, the weak and the powerless.

In the Gospel today, as Jesus sits outside the Temple treasury, he teaches his disciples to be wary of people like the scribes, who flaunt their privilege and entitlement in public places. The rich and powerful have a false sense of their own importance. In contrast, Jesus honours the humble actions of another poor widow passing by. Although she only gives a tiny amount to the Temple, her contribution is all the more generous because she is

offering all that she has to the Lord. It is her example that we are asked to follow.

Let us pray this week for a generous and loving heart. May we never be afraid to give of ourselves to the Lord, so that we may bring about his Kingdom of love in the world today.
