rejected has become the cornerstone.
Second Reading: John 3: 1~2
Gospel: John 10: 11~18

Pas ors' We continue our journey through Eastertide, experiencing the joy of the Risen Lord. In the First Reading, St. Peter explains that the miracle he has been able to perform came not from him, but from the name of Jesus Christ, the keystone rejected by the builders.

In the **Gospel**, Jesus describes himself as the Good Shepherd, who is prepared to lay

down his life for us; he knows us intimately and wants to bring everyone into his fold. On this Day of Prayer for Vocations, we might pray that everyone should be willing and able to fulfil their own vocation. We continue to pray for war-torn countries, that they will find a Good Shepherd to guide them out of conflict.
