The month of November provides a special opportunity to remember and pray for our beloved dead.

On Friday, November 1st we celebrate All Saints' Day. In our churches, we have memorial books where the names of those dear to us are recorded and remembered.

On All Saints Day, we honour the Church in Heaven and on All Souls Day, we commemorate the Church in Purgatory ~ the deceased faithful who are on their way to Heaven. Their present period of purification will infallibly end with their

vision of God and union with the other saints. This, then, is not a day of mourning. We rejoice because our faithful departed have been judged worthy to be with God.

In the gospel reading ~ the first passage (Luke 7:11–17) describes Jesus raising the only son of a widowed mother in Nain, which instills awe and the recognition of a great prophet in the crowd. The attention on this Sunday's readings often focuses on themes of compassion, recognizing God's power, and the importance of gratitude.

On this Solemnity, we can take encouragement from knowing that we belong to an eternal community of saints. With them, let us pray as **Pilgrims of Hope** for all those who are persecuted for expressing their faith in the Gospel.
